will be held at the John Kell O.A.M. Memorial Range, Bald Hill Road, Hill End, NSW.

Saturday 24th August

Morning – Welcome and Dedication (flag raising) followed by, Registration – Targetry Instruction, Range Safety and Rifle Maintenance. Afternoon – 200yds Core event Fromelles Tag prize

Sunday 25th August

Tin Hat Trophy for Marksmanship at 300 and 500yds. (Targets used will be original Tin Hat targets) 15rnds with 2 optional sighting shots at 300yds 15rnds with 2 optional sighting shots at 500yds. (Target rifles or as issued rifles in 303 British)

Prizes are only issued to competitors using as issued SMLE or No4 rifles chambered in .303 All other calibres (within licence allowance) are welcome to compete.

Prize Tags will be struck and awarded after the event. (The Tin Hat trophy is a perpetual trophy and is held by the Association Armourer)

Times –

The range will be open for camping and working parties on the afternoon of Fri. 23rd. Main event will start at 08:30 on Sun 25th. Prize giving will take place on afternoon/evening of the 25th, after scoring has been finalised.

Range and Shoot Rules -

All the standard range and safety rules will apply with the addition of the following: Eye and hearing protection is mandatory. Range Officers' word is final. No loaded firearms in camp. When transporting firearms around camp, on range etc. all bolts shall be REMOVED. Bolts may be inserted and actions closed when on the firing line and as directed by the Range Officer. Shoot is open to all comers who hold the appropriate licence. Allowable Firearm: Any military bolt action rifle in .303 British calibre fitted with iron sights. Front sight must be an un-shaded blade. No loading or discharging of firearms at any time without range officer's approval. Any spotting scope left on the mound may be used by other shooters. Slings on as-issued battle rifle must be issue. Length of sling may be altered. The ranges are measured in YARDS, not metres. The same firearm must be used during all stages of the shoot. All ammunition to be factory Mk. VII or loaded to Mk. VII velocity. A time limit of 43 seconds per shot from the time the target appears will apply. Permitted Fullbore type jackets. Military tunics are encouraged. Slouch hats, giggle hats, Akubras, & etc. Single point or other slings on target rifles. Shooting mats, groundsheets, spotting scopes. Reloaded ammunition... All reloads must be loaded to Mk.VII velocity. Not Permitted, Recoil pads, custom buttstocks, shaded or ring front sights, telescopic sights, eagle eyes and diopters. Hooded peaked caps, shooting mitts or gloves, shooting glasses and blinds. Anything else that in the organisers' opinion is not in the spirit of the event

Camping –

There is plenty of room for camping on the range. There are no facilities available apart from firewood, which is in plentiful supply, and pit toilets. Hot showers and flush toilets are available at the camping ground approx. 1km away. (You'll need a \$1 coin for showers)
There is accommodation available at the Royal Hotel, Hill End ph. 02 63378261, or the Hill End Lodge ph 02 63378200 Campfires are not to be built up and left unattended. Be aware that fire restrictions may apply. All rubbish is to be removed. There is a rubbish tip located approx 300m. further along Bald Hill Road. Chainsaws are tolerated (only just). Generators, ghetto blasters and car stereos are not. All dogs are to be kept on leads at all times.
